About the Cover Picture

Our cover photo comes from The Church of All Nations. Completed in 1924 with funding from numerous countries (hence the name), the Church stands at the base of the Mount of Olives in Jerusalem alongside the Garden of Gethsemane facing the walls of the Old City. It commemorates the site where Jesus prayed having full knowledge of His crucifixion. One can see the seal of the United States of America at this section of the ceiling. The sight of symbols of many nations reminds us that Jesus died for the Elect from nations not even imagined at that time.
